## 2030 Agenda & Biodiversity: Declaration

**§9:** *“We envisage a world in which [...] development and the application of technology [...] respect **biodiversity** and are resilient. One in which humanity lives in harmony with nature and in which wildlife and other living species are protected.”*

**§14:** *«Natural resource depletion and adverse impacts of environmental degradation, including, desertification, drought, land degradation, freshwater scarcity and **loss of biodiversity**, add to and exacerbate the list of challenges which humanity faces.»*

**§33:** *«We recognize that social and economic development depends on the sustainable management of our planet’s natural resources. We are therefore determined to conserve and sustainably use oceans and seas, freshwater resources, as well as forests, mountains and drylands and to protect **biodiversity**, ecosystems and wildlife.»*



# SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS





## Protect, restore and promote sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification, and halt and reverse land degradation and halt biodiversity loss

- 15.1 By 2020, ensure the conservation, restoration and sustainable use of terrestrial and inland freshwater **ecosystems** and their services
- 15.2 By 2020, promote sustainable management of all types of **forests**
- 15.3 Combat **desertification**
- 15.4 Ensure the conservation of **mountain ecosystems**, incl. their **biodiversity**
- 15.5 Reduce the degradation of **natural habitats**, halt the loss of **biodiversity** and, by 2020, protect and prevent the extinction of threatened species
- 15.6 Promote fair and equitable sharing of the benefits arising from the utilization of **genetic resources**
- 15.7 End **poaching and trafficking** of protected species of flora and fauna
- 15.8 By 2020, prevent the introduction and significantly reduce the impact of **invasive alien species**
- 15.9 By 2020, integrate **ecosystem and biodiversity values** into national and local planning

### Means of implementation

- 15.a/b Significantly **increase financial resources** from all sources to conserve and sustainably use **biodiversity**, ecosystems and forests
- 15.c Enhance global support for efforts to **combat poaching and trafficking** of protected species



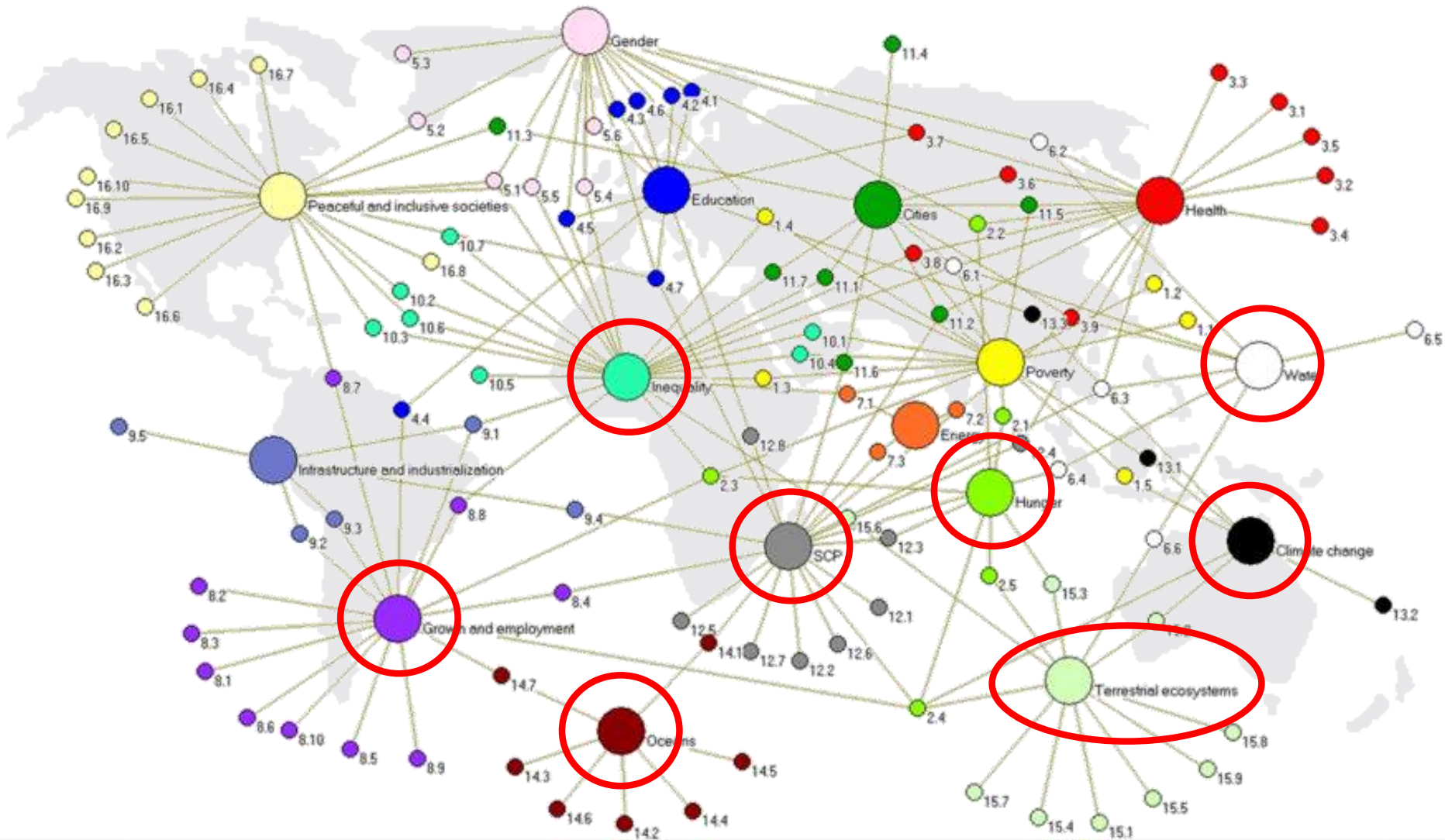

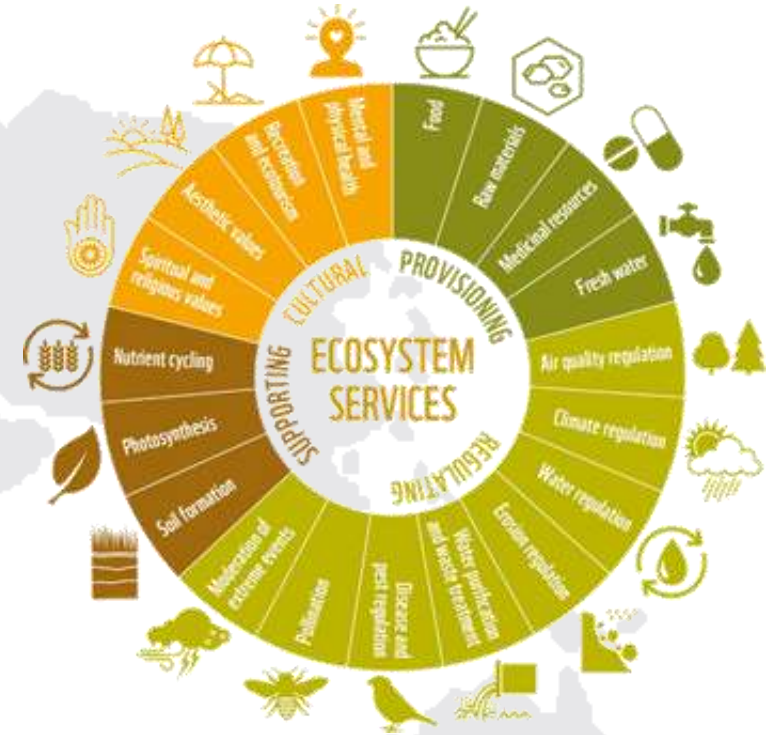
## Biodiversity: Function & Challenges

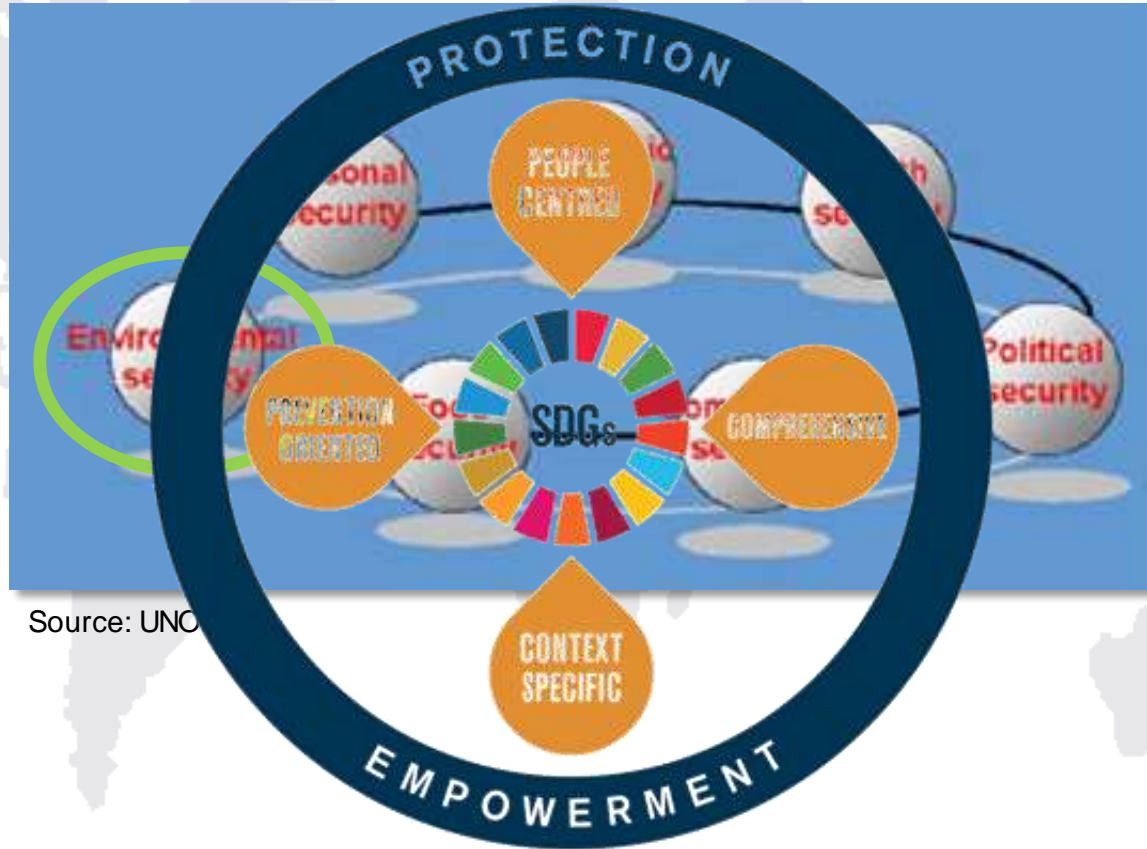

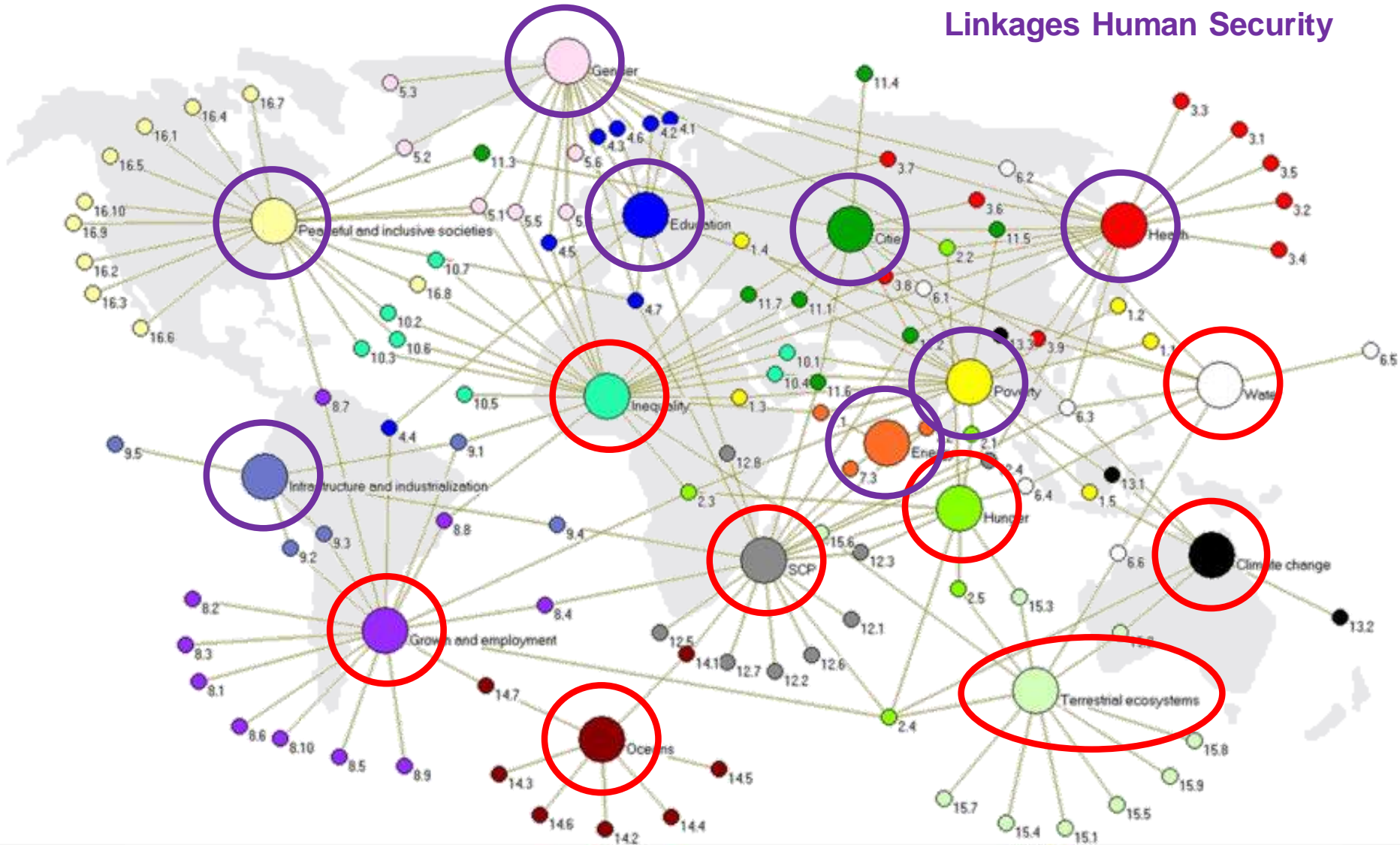

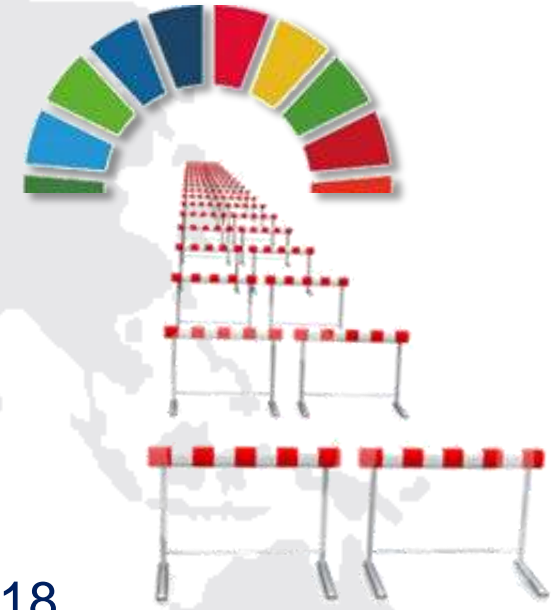

## Digital Reporting Tool DaRT

- Development supported by CH, EU & UNEP InforMEA in Geneva
- Goal: enhance use of synergies between Conventions & accelerate action
- Online platform with data on biodiversity
- System of cross-references among treaties and strategies
- For State Parties, UN Agencies and partners to implement:
  - Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020
  - Aichi Biodiversity Targets
  - 2030 Agenda & SDGs
- Basis for inter-sectoral action, e.g. re human security
