Work plan 2016 - 2017

Note by the Chair

Introduction

- 1. This note presents the work plan for the Environment Management Group (EMG) for the period 2016 2017. The draft plan builds on the work plan adopted by the 20th senior officials' meeting (SOM) of the EMG in 2014, and will be updated to reflect the decisions adopted by the 21st Senior Officials Meeting (SOM).
- 2. The work plan is given a two-year horizon, which is subject to annual approval by the senior officials. This approach is meant to capture activities which have a time span longer than one year. The plan, an overview of planned activities and milestones for the next 24 months, has four main expected accomplishments which pertain to programmatic, operational and management issues, as well as overall cooperation.
- 3. The work plan remains un-costed as there is no common budget for EMG activities. It is recommended that the work plan be implemented through in-kind contributions, subject to the availability of resources. The in-kind contributions will be budgeted, programmed and reported on by each member and the UNEP secretariat within their own administrative processes.

	a) Revise the Sustainability Framework in the light of the lessons learned in the pilot process and linkages with the 2030 Sustainable Development agenda;
	b) Address commonly identified implementation challenges and best practices in the Guide for Advancing the ESS Framework in the UN System in responding to those challenges;
	c) Carry out an analysis of the information gathered during the pilot process to identify possible common approaches, including minimum requirements and overall guiding principles to integrating and implementing environmental and social sustainability in the UN system;
	d) Create an online platform on environmental and social sustainability in the UN system for information exchange and sharing of best practices and lessons learned.

	c) Continue knowledge sharing, communication, training and awareness-raising activities, in particular through the Greening the Blue and the UNITE Connections platforms, on emissions reductions initiatives and various aspects of UN internal management such as facilities, procurement, events, travel, and e-communications;
	d) Design a new concept for an annual report on UN environmental performance based on the new inventory methodology;

	c) Consider developing guidelines and documenting good practices on how to conduct a review independently, as a useful management tool and a valuable complement to, and means of sustaining, the peer review process.
